The Museum, located in Jerusalem within the walls of the Holy City, will have two sites:

- St. Saviour's Monastery near the New Gate for the history section
- the Monastery of the Flagellation near the Lions' Gate
 on the "Way of the Cross and the Holy Sepulchre" for the archaeology and multimedia sections
