







## "As ancient as an olive tree, as young as its fruit" Contest

Terms and Conditions

Art. 1 Objective

The Award is addressed to Palestinians and encourages them to creatively re-use the Terra Sancta Museum collections.

Art. 2 The design

The design you enter meets any and all applicable statutory safety regulations. You indemnify Pro Terra Sancta Association (PTS), the Terra Sancta Museum (TSM), and all those involved in organizing the Award against any third-party claims in respect thereof.

You are inspired by the Terra Sancta Museum collection and your design:

- Is unique and is not yet on the market
- Is a creative remix of (one or more) objects from the Terra Sancta Museum collections
- Can be reproduced

All forms of art are allowed.

Art. 3 Prizes

The contest will assign three awards:

- 1. Terra Sancta Design Award, the winner will receive € 2.500
- 2. Young Designer Terra Sancta Award (aged 25 and under), the winner will receive € 1.500
- 3. People's Choice Terra Sancta Design Award, the winner will receive € 1.000

No correspondence will be entered into with respect to the results and the prizes.

Art. 4 Timeline

Submission of the design: 23:59 (GMT+03) 30 September 2022

Communication of selected design: 5 October 2022

Opening of online vote: 10 October 2022

Arrival of design to the museum: by 24 October 2022

Presentation Day: 31 October 2022

Art. 5 Entering/registering

The closing day for entries is 30 September 2022, 23:59 (GMT +03)

The competition is open to Palestinians (natural persons and companies) aged 18 and above

A design can be entered as a collaboration, in which case it will be deemed a single entry eligible for a single prize

A design entered by a person aged between 18 and 25 years will compete for the category "Young Designer". If the design is presented as a collaboration, the age of the team's oldest member will determine the category.

All designs will compete for the category "People's Choice".

Entry is free of charge

### Art. 4 Entry requirements

The body organizing the Award can exclude designs that do not meet the conditions before, during and after the judging.

You are personally responsible for ensuring that your design and the accompanying digital visual material are submitted in full. You cover the cost of producing the visual material and any prototype yourself.

If you are competing for the "Young Designer" category, you can submit a request for financial support to produce your prototype (up to max. 150€). If the jury selects your design, we will get in touch with you to produce the prototype at our expense.

## Art. 5 Entering the design

You can only enter if you have submitted a complete digital form on the TSM website. We do not accept physical submissions.

Your design should be submitted as a digital document with a description (of no more than 1000 words in English and Arabic) and images (no more than 10) or video (no more than 2 minutes) using the TSM website dedicated page.

# Art. 6 Exhibiting and promotion

The nominated designs will be exhibited for 4 weeks at Terra Sancta Museum

If you are nominated for a prize, we ask you to make your design available (including any prototype) for the Award presentation on 31 October 2022 and the subsequent exhibition period.

The person/team behind the nominated designs will bear the costs and responsibility for transporting and packaging the design. This also includes any transport insurance.

The TSM and PTS will take the usual care when handling the works being exhibited during the Award presentation and the exhibition period. HOWEVER, the TSM and PTS are not liable for any damage to the work that may arise as a result of any (hidden) flaws or construction errors or for any damage that can be attributed to the participant.

### Promotion

Pro Terra Sancta and Terra Sancta Museum undertake to offer adequate promotion of designers through:

- exhibiting their works at Terra Sancta Museum
- the participation of journalists, curators, and institutions on the presentation day
- publicity through their own and their partners' online channels
- publication of a catalogue

## Art. 7 Intellectual Property

By submitting your design, you warrant that your design is your creation, that it does not breach the rights of others, such as copyrights, design rights, and trademark rights, and you indemnify Pro Terra Sancta and the Terra Sancta Museum against any claims from third parties who think they hold pre-existing rights to your work.

#### Art. 8 Results

The names of the members of the jury will be announced on the TSM website.

The jury will select the designs that will be presented and exhibited. One winner for each category will be nominated. The jury will select the winners for the Terra Sancta Design Award and the Young Designer Terra Sancta Award.

All selected designs will be published online on 10 October 2022, and the one that will receive more votes will be nominated winner of the People's Choice Terra Sancta Design Award

## Art. 9 Putting the winning design into production

Pro Terra Sancta association and the Terra Sancta Museum are entitled to:

- Exhibit your work
- Use your work for PR or marketing purposes. Upon request, the Pro Terra Sancta association and the Terra Sancta Museum will endeavour to state the name of the designer where possible.

They reserve the right, in any case, to realize the competition designs and possibly put them into production. In this case, the designers will be paid a royalty through a contract that is independent and separate from this Call for Entries.

#### Art. 10 Miscellaneous

The competition is not open to employees and freelancers working with Pro Terra Sancta association and/or the Terra Sancta Museum, members of their families, and the partners of the Terra Sancta Design Award.
